Comments:

1. TCPC is sponsoring the “Wireless Networking Symposium”. The co-sponsoring TCs are the Technical Committee on Satellites and the Technical Committee on Switching. Prof. Ibrahim Habib is chairing this symposium and there are two vice chairs: Prof. Romano Fantacci (Satellite Committee) and Prof. Franco Vatalaro. The TPC of the symposium is currently being formed. There are around 15 members at the moment; any TCPC member interested in joining should send an e-mail to Ibrahim.

2. TCPC will also sponsor tutorials and Business Applications Panels. Members who are interested in submitting proposals, please send an email to Ibrahim.

3. The ICC 2004 TPC meeting during this event will be attended by Romano (Vice Chair). Ibrahim will not be able to attend this meeting personally, however he will sign in to the conference call.

4. Technical Activities Council Announcements:

Zygmunt reported on discussions which took place during the ComSoc Technical Activities Council (TAC) meeting held earlier during this event.

- There are 21 Technical Committees (TCs) under ComSoc’s TAC. The TCs are supposed to work without conflict and competition, but rather in a complementary manner. In this context the TC & TC chair functions are being reviewed.
- Each TC has a conference representative (rep) in Globecom’s and ICC’s (GICC). In the upcoming GICC’s (perhaps starting in 2005), these 21 TC reps will be in the Technical Program Committees of the corresponding conferences. All GICC’s will have a general

conference and a number of (not too many) specialized symposia on hot topics. The Symposia Chairs will be chosen by the TP Chair in consultation with the Chairs of the sponsoring TCs.

- There is a growing concern on the usage of the “ComSoc-sponsored” label by various events. TC’s do not have the final authority for technical endorsements; this authority resides with ComSoc. The events should not use the labels as “IEEE COMSOC sponsored (pending)” or “Endorsed/sponsored by IEEE ComSoc TCxx”.
- JSAC welcomes special issue proposals supported by TCs.

5. Election of New TCPC Officers:

The call for nominations had been distributed to the TCPC membership through e-mail earlier. Zygmunt reported that there were two set of nominations as follows:

The nominees Khaled, Bassam, and Halim were presented during the meeting. Zygmunt asked them to leave the room while the discussions took place. When the nominees were called back to the meeting room, the new Officer (for the period January 1, 2003 to December 31, 2004) were announced by Zygmunt:
